# BOS Career Guidance and Counseling Centre activities

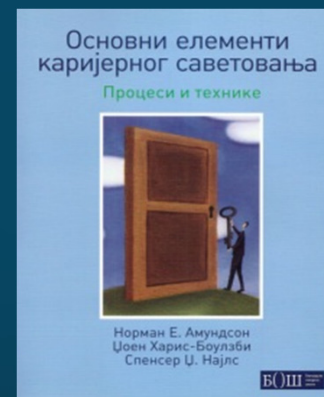
